



Philatelic Postage stamp issue – SEPAC

On the 27th July MaltaPost will be participating in a forthcoming philatelic stamp issue by SEPAC (Small European Postal Administration Cooperation) themed 'Spectacular Views'. By this issue members will be showcasing views of landscapes of their respective countries. Malta's issue will consist of four stamps reproducing the winning photos from a competition that was held last year.

The €0.26 stamp features the church of Saint John the Baptist, commonly known as the Xewkija Rotunda. This Roman Catholic Church in Gozo was built in the 20th century on the site of a previous 17th century church and is reputedly the world's third highest unsupported dome. The €0.42 stamp features, Għajn Tuffieħa Bay near Manikata village. The bay is located in the northwest coast of Malta and considered as one of the main bathing sites. Photography by Martin Galea

The €0.59 stamp features the Gozo Aqueduct, also known as 'tal-Ħammimiet', was built during the British Rule between 1839 and 1843. It covered a distance of 2 kilometres and supplied fresh water, from the heights of Għar Ilma to Victoria, the main town of Gozo. Photography by Darren Vella

The €1.25 stamp features Dwejra Bay, located in the northwestern end of Gozo. It is well known for its dramatic coastal formation, its shallow inland sea and is a foremost tourist attraction. Photography by Norbert Juhasz

The stamps will be issued in sheets of 10 stamps with each stamp measuring 44mm x 31mm, and a perforation of 13.9x 14.0 (comb) bearing the Maltese Cross watermark. The sheets measure 118mm x 185mm. Printex Limited produced the set in offset and the issue consists of 1,000,000 of the €0.26, 40,000 of the €0.42 stamp, 650,000 of the €0.59 and 30,000 of the €1.25 stamp. MaltaPost se tippartecipa fil-ħarġa ta' bolli SEPAC (Small European Postal Administration Cooperation) bit-tema 'Spectacular Views'. Permezz ta' din il-ħarġa il-membri se jkunu qed juru xeni ta' pajsagġi minn pajjiżhom. Malta se toħroġ sett ta' erba' bolli li juru ritratti rebbieħa minn kompetizzjoni li kienet saret is-sena l-oħra.

Il-bolla tas-€0.26 turi l-knisja ta' San Ġwann il-Battista, magħrufa l-aktar bħala r-Rotunda tax-Xewkija. Din il-knisja Kattolika Rumana f'Għawdex inbniet fis-seklu għoxrin fil-ġenb ta' knisja tas-seklu 17 u jingħad li hija it-tielet l-akbar koppla fid-dinja. Fotografija ta' Camille Cassar

Il-bolla tat-€0.42 turi l-bajja t'Għajn Tuffieħa ħdejn il-villaġġ tal-Manikata. Il-bajja tinsab fit-tramuntana ta' Malta u hija kunsidrata bħala waħda mill-bajjiet l-aktar popolari għall-għawn. Fotografija ta' Martin Galea

Il-bolla tad-€0.59 turi l-akwadott ta' Għawdex magħruf l-aktar bħala 'tal-Ħammimiet', li kien inbena taħt l-Inglizi bejn l-1839 u l-1843. Dan jkopri distanza ta' 2 kilometri u jagħti ilma minn Għar Ilma għar-Rabat, Għawdex. Fotografija ta' Darren Vella

Il-bolla tal-€1.25 turi l-bajja tad-Dwejra, li tinsab fit-tramuntana ta' Għawdex. Hija magħrufa għall-fomazzjoni drammatika tagħha u hija attrazzjoni kbira għat-turisti. Fotografija ta' Nobert Juhasz

Il-bolli se jinħarġu f'folji ta' għaxra. Kull bolla hija ta' daqs 44mm x 31mm, u għandha perforazzjoni ta' 13.9x 14.0 (comb) bis-Salib ta' Malta. Il-folji huma ta' daqs 118mm x 185mm. Printex ipproduċa dan is-sett b'metodu offset u l-ħarġa tikkonsisti f'1,000,000 tas-€0.26, 40,000 tal-€0.42, 650,000 tad-€0.59 u 30,000 tal-€1.25. Din il-ħarġa filatelika se tkun għall-bejgħ minn nhar il-Ġimgħa 27 ta' Lulju 2018 mill-Ferġat Postali kollha.
